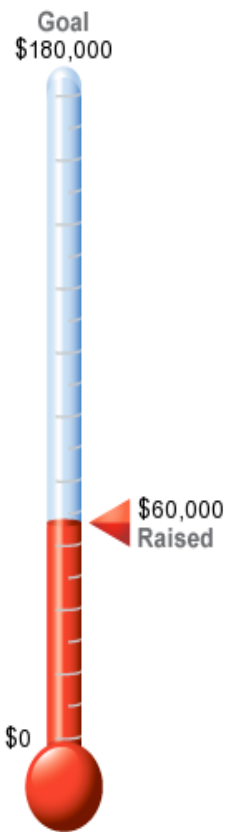
We are also looking to increase the size of the executive. If you, or any of your friends would be interested in being co-opted to the executive, please do not hesitate to contact us.

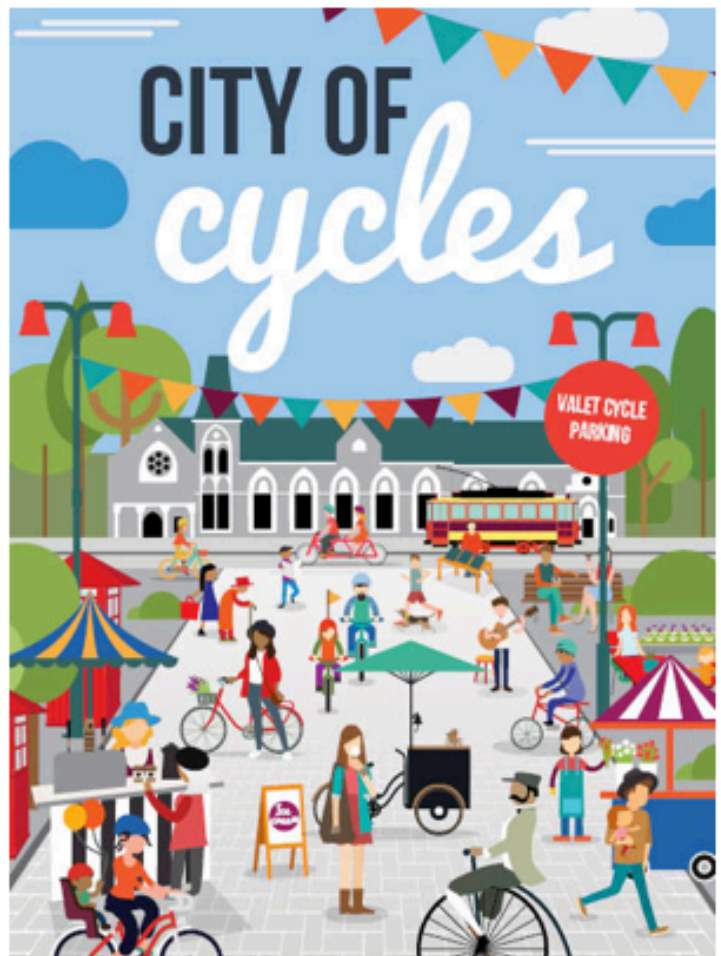


## Heritage Week is here!
